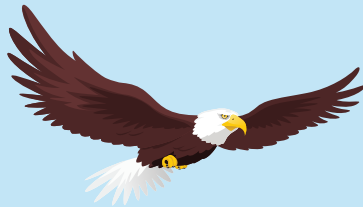

Cost of living & travel in New York City



- Standard city one-way bus ticket: 2 – 3 USD
- Monthly pass: 120 - 140 USD
- Taxi fare: 2.50 USD (initial standard fare)
1.56 USD (per km)



- Standard pint of beer: 5 – 9 USD
- 3-course meal for 2 people:
90 – 140 USD



- Typical hotel for 2 adults:
250 - 300 USD (per night)
- Average rent for 2-bedroom apartment:
2,275 - 4,200 USD (per month)



- Doctor's visit: 150 – 200 USD
