Cost of living & travel in Prague



- **Standard city one-way bus ticket:** 30 CZK / 30 minutes – 40 CZK / 90 minutes
- **Monthly transport pass:** 550 CZK
- **Taxi fare:** 40 CZK (initial charge); 28 CZK (per km)



- **Standard pint of beer:** 45 CZK
- **3-course meal for 2 people:** 850 – 1,300 CZK



- **Average rent for 1-bedroom apartment:** 2,200 – 2,500 CZK (per month)



- **15 Minute doctor's visit:** 300 CZK for those insured in Czech Republic, 1000 CZK for those who are not

Costs are based on average in Prague, Czech Republic in July 2021; costs will vary from region to region.
