Cost of living & travel in **Bali**



- **Standard bus ticket:** 20,000 IDR
- **Daily pass for all transport:** 100,000 IDR
- **Taxi fare:** 7000 IDR (initial charge); 7525 IDR (per km)



- **Standard pint of beer:** 30,000 – 40,000 IDR
- **3-course meal for 2 people:** 425,000 – 550,000 IDR



- **Typical hotel for 2 adults:** 433,000 – 866,000 IDR (per night)
- **Average rent for 1-bedroom apartment:** 4,437,500 - 7,871,000 IDR (per month)



- **Doctor's visit:** 205,000 IDR
